INSTRUCTIONS:

1 – EITHER PRINT A COPY OF THE BOTTOM PAGE OR TRACE THE "DOG" INTO YOUR SKETCHBOOK.

2 – BOTH "DOGS" MUST BE ON THE PAGE

3 – YOUR DOODLE DOG MUST HAVE AN EYE.

4 – THE DOODLE DOGS MUST BE "OPPOSITES". THINK OF A THEME THAT IS BASED ON OPPOSITES: GOOD VS. EVIL, LIGHT VS. DARK... THEY MUST SHOW A COMPLETE OPPOSITE IDEA SO THINK BEFORE YOU START.

5 – OUTLINE YOUR DRAWINGS IN BLACK SHARPIE AND COLOR THEM IN – COLORED PENCIL, CRAYONS, PAINT, WHATEVER.

6 -- THE THEME MUST BE WRITTEN SOMEWHERE ON THE DOODLE DOG PAGE.

7 – THE FOLLOWING THEMES ARE BANNED – GOOD VS. EVIL, LIGHT VS. DARK, BOY VS. GIRL, NIGHT VS. DAY, HAPPY VS. SAD.

YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DO ANYTHING THAT IS DEEMED "EASY" LIKE BLACK VS. WHITE... THERE MUST BE A THOUGHT PROCESS BEHIND YOUR DESIGN. IF IT'S TOO EASY THEN IT WILL NOT BE GRADED.
